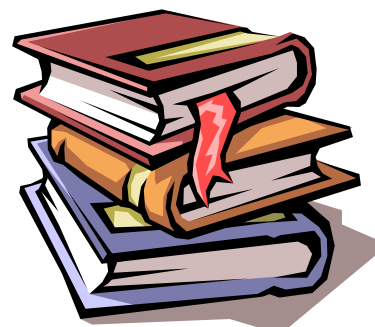

D11NR Uniform Policy Update

 Hot Weather ODU (T-Shirt) Wear authorized

USCG Auxiliary, in D11NR, is authorized to wear Coast Guard dark blue crew neck T-shirts as part of the Hot Weather Uniform. The Hot Weather ODU uniform is appropriate in locations where humidity and high temperatures cause physical discomfort for personnel performing outdoor activities.

Official guidelines for wearing the Coast Guard dark blue T-Shirt are:

The T-Shirt can be worn with the Operational Dress Uniform (ODU) long pants, modified ODU trousers hemmed 1 to 4 inches above the knee or the earlier Hot Weather Uniform blue shorts.

The T-Shirt may not be worn with the working blue long pants.

The T-shirt must be stenciled with the words “USCG AUXILIARY” across the front left chest in white ¾ inch tall block-style letters. The T-shirt can be ordered through our District Store.

Until the ODU uniform becomes more widely accepted, crew’s working together on a patrol may be dressed in either uniform, staying within the guidelines for whichever being worn.
