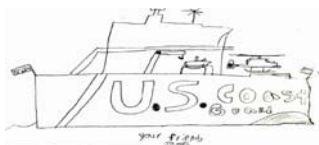

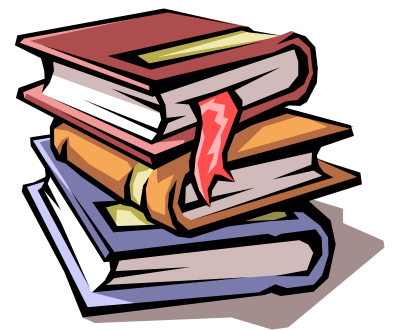

John was born in South Dakota but raised in Lincoln, Nebraska until he graduated from high school and enlisted in the CG from 1988-1992. During his enlistment, he served on the icebreaking ship CGC Northwind for 6 months, and the rest of his time at Search and Rescue (SAR) stations in Oregon and Washington as a Machinery Technician (MK). After his enlistment, he went back to Nebraska and obtained a BS Degree in Geology from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln (UNL). He moved to Idaho where he obtained a MS Degree in Waste Management and Environmental Studies from Idaho State University in 2001. He briefly worked for the Idaho Department of Environmental Quality out of Twin Falls, ID, when he decided to re-join the CG after 9/11. He was commissioned as an officer via Officer Candidate School (OCS) and stationed at MSO San Francisco Bay. While here at the MSO (re-organized as Sector San Francisco), he worked for 2 years as a Marine Inspector and now he is working as an Investigator. He has about 6 months left here at the unit. This summer he'll begin another MS Degree in Industrial Hygiene and begin a CG career path as an Industrial Hygienist.
